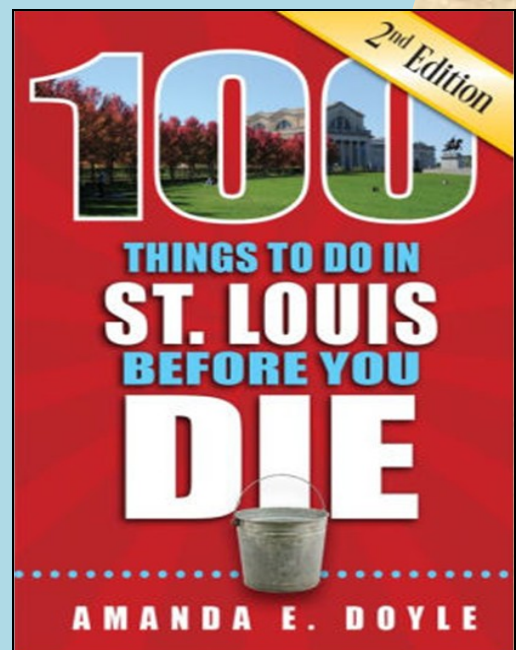
## “100 THINGS TO DO IN ST. LOUIS BEFORE YOU DIE”
