

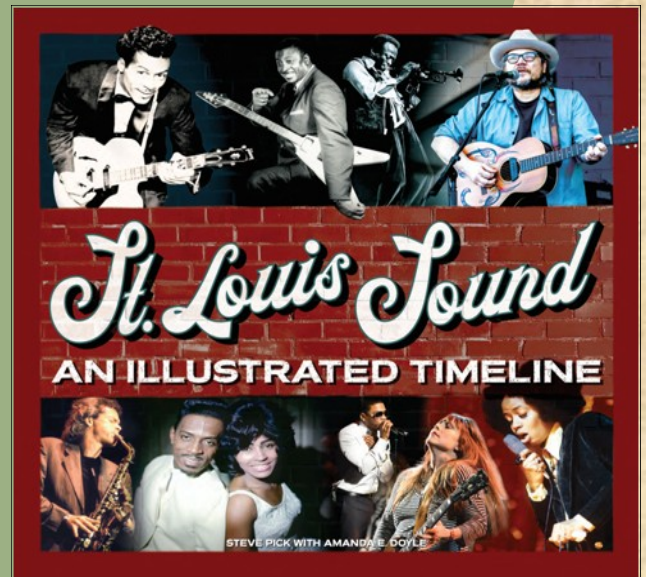
# THIRD TUESDAYS AT THE LIBRARY
