

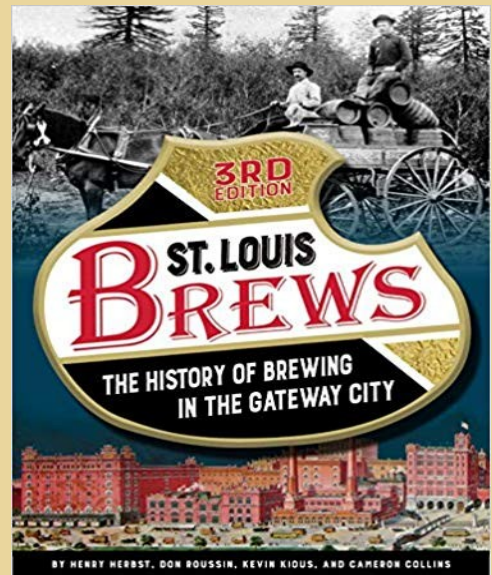
# ST. LOUIS BREWS: The History of Brewing in the Gateway City
